

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS ADMISSION POLICY

International Student Admissions

- Lenoir Community College (LCC) has been approved by the U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service to enroll international students from the following categories:
 1. Permanent residents with alien registration (green card)
 2. Refugees/Asylum
 3. F-1 visa, M-1 visa
 4. B-2 visa bearing the notation “prospective student”
(may not enroll until F-1 status is approved)

- LCC has been approved by the INS to issue I-20 forms and enroll F-1 visa international students in AA, AS, AAS, diploma, and certificates of study.

- LCC has also been approved by the INS to issue I-20 forms and enroll M-1 visa international students in AA, AS, AAS, diploma, and certificates of study.

- **Application for admission should be made at least six (6) months prior to the semester in which the applicant plans to enroll.**

- International students are treated as nonresidents of the state of North Carolina with respect to tuition and fees. Length of stay, payment of taxes, or ownership of property does not qualify an international student for the status of legal resident.

- The College is unable to provide financial aid to international students; therefore, international students must have sufficient funds to cover all living expenses, tuition, and fees while attending the College.

- Student housing is not provided by the College. International students are expected to make their own arrangements for housing.
