

## DOCUMENTS TO BRING

### **Hand carry these items: DO NOT PUT THEM IN A SUIT CASE**

1. Your passport, valid for at least six months beyond the date of your expected stay
2. SEVIS Form I-20 or DS-2019 form
3. Evidence of financial resources
4. Evidence of student status such as recent tuition receipts and transcripts
5. Paper receipt for SEVIS fee, Form I-797
6. Name and contact information for your “Primary Designated School Official”, including a 24-hour emergency contact number at the school
7. Your Arrival-Departure Record Form (I-94)
8. Customs Declaration (CF-6059)

It is also a good idea to bring an official copy of your birth certificate.

If possible bring detailed and up-to date medical & dental records for yourself and any dependents who are traveling with you.

Bring official transcripts in English from secondary schools, colleges, or universities.

Bring contact information – include the name and phone number of individual at your U.S. university to contact in case of a travel delay.
