The Auctioneering course at Lenoir Community College will introduce students to all aspect of auctioneering. Students will be provided a practical and working knowledge of the auctioneering business.

Auctioneering is designed to train individual in the skills needed to become licensed auctioneers. It is a 96-hour course accredited by the North Carolina Auctioneer Licensing Board. Students will learn all aspects of auctioneering.

Satisfactory completion of the course will make students eligible to take the North Carolina Auctioneering Exam, which is given at various times during the year.
