EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN-BASIC-trains individuals to become emergency medical personnel. Teaches performing patient assessments, basic life support techniques, including AED, Basic and Advanced airway management and CPR, hemorrhage control, O2 administration, treating shock, bandaging/dressing, splinting, treating skull, spine, and chest injuries, childbirth, lifting/moving patients to medical facilities, treating exposure to cold/heat, and basic life support for medical emergencies. Our latest addition, called **ALS Assist** prepares the basic EMT to assist advanced life support personnel on scene of an emergency. Must be 18 years of age; textbook required. High School Diploma/GED required. able to read at the 10th grade level.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL DISPATCHER (EMD)

The Emergency Medical Dispatcher (EMD) has been recognized as an essential component of effective EMS systems. Proper and timely training as well as a sound medical protocol are what help EMDs deliver quality care to the calling public with emergency medical needs. Participants who complete the 2-day course will be eligible for certification through the National (or International) Academy of EMD. To be EMD-certified, the applicant must also be CPR-certified through the National Safety Council, American Heart Association, American Red Cross, European Resuscitation Council or equivalent. We recommend this training be completed prior to attending the EMD course.
