Some Quick Facts about the Student Government Association (SGA)

- SGA serves as the student voice on campus.
- SGA supports student activities such as athletic events, cookouts, blood drives, community projects, a student newsletter and curriculum activities.
- LCC's Student Government Association is a member of the North Carolina Comprehensive Community College Student Government Association (N4CSGA).
- Members may be eligible to attend leadership conferences sponsored by N4CSGA and to participate on the state level.

What is the SGA?

The SGA is designed to enhance the general welfare of students and to facilitate communication between the student body, the faculty, and the administration. The Association provides a means through which students can participate in the governance of the college. The Coordinator of Student Activities serves as advisor to the Association. SGA sponsors campus-wide student activities. These activities are funded by the student activity fee paid by students at registration.

Who can be involved in SGA?

We encourage input and participation from all students. Every student at Lenoir Community College who pays an activity fee is a member of the Student Government Association and may attend the meetings. Elected officers of each club, SGA senators and the SGA officers are the only representatives that may vote on issues; however, all students are encouraged to attend the meetings. SGA officers are elected at the end of Spring. Along with the advisors, these officers comprise the SGA Executive Board. The SGA may have one senator per 100 students (i.e. if we have 2,000 students, then the SGA may elect 20 students to represent the student body.)
