Dear LPN to ADN Transition Applicant:

Thank you for applying to Lenoir Community College's LPN to ADN Transition program. The following information is important. Please complete each step in this admissions process.

1. Complete or update your general college application in the Admissions Office.
2. Complete the LPN to ADN Transition application and leave in the Admissions Office by November 26, 2003.
3. Provide official high school (or equivalent) and all college transcripts to Admissions.
4. Pick up the Math-Pharmacology Study Guide from Admissions (dated September 2003) and self-review.
5. Schedule the Math-Pharmacology exam with Cathy Manning at 252-527-6223 extension 800. Exam Date: Monday, December 8, 2003, Health Sciences Building #13, Room 215 at 2:00 p.m. (2½ hours will be allotted for the exam.) Please be prompt. Latecomers will not be tested.
6. You will be notified during the week of December 15, 2003 regarding your admission into the program.
7. NUR189 – Nursing Transition starts February 2, 2004 at 12:15 p.m. If admitted, you will need to register on Tuesday, January 6, 2004 anytime between 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

NOTE: You must have proof of the following before the program application is processed:

1. MAT080 with a "C" or higher within five years.
2. CHM090 with a "C" or higher within five years. This course may be waived for LPN's if BIO168/169 (or equivalent) is complete with a "C" or higher.
3. PSY150, BIO168, BIO169 with a "C" or better.
4. Current unrestricted license to practice as an LPN in North Carolina. The certificate number and expiration date will be included in your admissions data.
