What is the Ambassadors Program?

The Ambassadors Program at Lenoir Community College is an opportunity to learn leadership skills, develop networking skills, and become an active participant in college activities.

Ambassadors will serve as representatives of the college both on campus and in the community. Their duties include:

- conducting campus tours for visitors and prospective students
- serving at official LCC and LCC Foundation events
- participating in fund-raising activities
- assisting during registration and orientation events



Who is eligible to participate?

Students are selected through an application and interview process conducted by the LCC Scholarship Committee. Applicants' qualifications should include

- maintaining a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher,
- sustaining good standing in the community and institution,
- being a full-time student,
- a commitment to complete the academic year of scholarship award,
- the ability to complete the required 40 service hours per semester.

A decision to apply for the LCC Ambassador Program reflects a student's commitment to academic success, development of leadership skills, and giving back to others through college activities.
