Chartered in 1958 by the State Board of Education, Lenoir Community College (LCC) began operating in 1960 as the Lenoir County Industrial Educational Center with the first classes held at Contentnea School. In 1963, LCC became part of the North Carolina Community College System, which was established in 1963 under an enactment of a general statute by the legislature. LCC was initially accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges in 1968 and has maintained accreditation ever since.

One of the oldest institutions in the NC Community College System, LCC's main campus is located in Kinston, North Carolina. Its primary service area is Lenoir, Greene, and Jones counties. Lenoir Community College's mission is to "meet the personal, cultural, and professional educational needs of our students through affordable, accessible, and innovative educational programs." This commitment to opportunity is reflected in the College's open-door admissions policy. Individuals 18 years old or older and able to profit from further formal education, or a high school graduate under 18, may be admitted to the College. Individuals under 18 years of age who have not attained graduation from high school can attend the College as stipulated by the policies of the State Board of Community Colleges.

The comparable sizes of LCC's Continuing Education and Curriculum divisions make it unique within the NC Community College System. During the 2022-2023 academic year, LCC served approximately 9,800 unduplicated Curriculum and Continuing Education students. Of those approximately 9,800 students, 43% were classified as white, 40% as black, 14% Hispanic, approximately 1% Multiple race/ethnicity, and approximately 2% American Indian/Alaskan or Asian. Additionally, 54% of 2022-2023's enrollment resided in LCC's tri-county service area and only 2% of the total enrollment resided outside of North Carolina. According to the North Carolina Community College System, LCC ranked 21th in unduplicated enrollment headcount among the 58 North Carolina community colleges in 2022-2023. LCC considers its peers as Johnston Community College and Craven Community College due to their proximity and similar annual enrollment.

The College is committed to quality education and student success and offers 43 associate degree programs, 19 diploma programs, and 66 certificate/skills certificate programs and 4 Career and College Promise Pathways. LCC is also well recognized for its health sciences and nursing, business, industrial, public safety, continuing education, college transfer programs, and collaborative programs with the local public high schools.
