WHAT IS WIOA?

The Workforce Innovation & Opportunity Act (WIOA) is designed to help job seekers access employment, education, training, and support services to succeed in the labor market and to match employers with the skilled workers they need to compete in the global economy.

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?

You are eligible for WIOA services if you are between the ages of 16 and 24 years old and meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Attending Adult High School (AHS) classes or not enrolled in school
- Involved in the justice system
- In foster care system or aged out
- Homeless
- Pregnant or parenting
- Youth with a disability
- Low-income and need assistance to enter or complete an educational program or to secure employment

SERVICES

- School/tuition and textbook assistance
- On-the-Job Training (OJT)
- Paid/unpaid work experience
- Assistance with Occupational Skills Training and Short-Term Certificates
- Tutoring/Remediation
- Financial Literacy
- Leadership Development
