On page 142 under the revised date of the Criminal Justice Technology (A55180) program add the following statement: This degree satisfies the requirements for the Dual Enrollment Agreement with Fayetteville State University.

The following statement needs to be added to Emergency Medical Science A45340 and Emergency Medical Science-Bridging A45340B at the bottom of pages 158 and 159: All Emergency Medical Science students must make grades of “A,” “B,” or “C” on all major courses to graduate from the program.

On page 157 in the Emergency Medical Technician-Basic Certificate (C45340C1) a new section needs to be added (III Other Major Courses 4 Hours) and ACA-111 and CIS-110 need to be moved into that section.

On page 349 remove MAT 070 from the prerequisites of SUR 110. It is unnecessary since students must complete MAT 070 to be admitted to the Surgical Technology program.

On page 350 the course description for SUR 135 needs to be corrected to read as follows: This course provides clinical experience with a variety of perioperative assignments to build skills required for complex perioperative patient care. Emphasis is placed on greater technical skills, critical thinking, speed, efficiency, and autonomy in the operative setting. Upon completion, students should be able to function in the role of an entry-level surgical technologist.

On page 350 delete SUR 137 from the Co-requisites for the course SUR 135 to align with the CCL.

On page 319 the first sentence of the description for MTH 220 should read: “This course provides knowledge and skills in more complex body work modalities **in a variety of clinical settings**.” (“in a variety of clinical settings” has been left off.)

On page 13 “Information Highway/Two-way Video (IH) needs to be in all caps.

On page 15 the document title *Student Educational Records Policy* needs to have an “s” added to the word student to read *Students’ Educational Records Policy*.

On page 272 the Dietetic Technician ~~courses need to be added back to the catalog~~ as they were listed in the 2011/12 catalog.

On page 324, the following prerequisites for NOS-120 and NOS-130 need to be corrected to read: Prerequisites: State, NOS 110 or CET 211

On page 271 the following prerequisites for CUL-160 and CUL-170 need to be corrected to read: Prerequisites: State, CUL 110
